The volunteers will be hosted for 10 weeks in Peja/Pec, Kosovo, and will have the opportunity to experience the diverse cultures of all communities that make up the mountainous border region. The volunteers will have the opportunity of working on an international team, in a cross-border region, in a NGO capacity, while increasing and promoting transboundary mountain sustainable development. Intercultural learning is integral to the BPP cross-border cooperation, and this Group EVS is a self-development opportunity for the volunteers to learn and grow themselves, as well as through exchange with local youth and internationals working in Kosovo. Together the youth of Europe will share a vision for the future, and protect Europe's environmental values.
