The applicant LGB Youth Support Group COME OUT has gathered following partners (1) Associazione Culturale ARCI Strauss, Italy; (2) YSLU Graduates Association, Armenia; (3) Youth organization Yagmuroglu, Turkey; (4) U.S.B., Greece; (5) PORA!, Ukraine; (6) AAYSA, Azerbaijan; and (7) "H2O", Portugal. The total of 24 youth workers and young people will gather in Novi Sad (Serbia) in April 2014 for 10 days to learn, explore and share knowledge, skills and experiences so that they can develop new programs which will provide empowerment for young LGBT people in their communities. The program of the activity is designed in respect to the principles of human rights based approach, youth work and social education, while using the methodology of experiential and accelerated learning. The topics covered with the program are: human rights concepts, the history of LGBT movement, social mechanisms of homophobia, sexual orientation and sexual identity, adolescence and sexuality, forms of organized psycho-social support, stereotypes, prejudice, discrimination, and project writing. Also, they will visit the Organizational Board of Belgrade Pride and have opportunity to talk with local LGBT activists. Besides established partnerships and developed project ideas, the participants will present their experience through a booklet highlighting the most important aspects when planning and implementing activities for young LGBT people which will be available for downloading from the promoters websites.
