The program is designed to focus on young people with different cultural and ethnical background (so called minorities) and to provide them with opportunity to explore the meaning of European values as their common identity. This exchange will encourage participants to become more involved in different activities happening in their countries, by increasing their understanding of European citizenship and youth participation. By bringing them together this project aims at fostering the feeling of sharing common European values and raising their sense of belonging to Europe. Host to this youth exchange will be Serbia, country very new to the idea of European enlargement but with great potential among youth willing to meet their peers from different countries. This exchange deals with European issues by integrating participants that are more (France, Italy) or less (Poland) familiar with European processes and participants with lack of information on course of European progression (Serbia, FYROM and Albania). 36 participants will be offered 4 modules designed to promote intercultural dialogue as one of the Europe's main values: 1) European values and identity, 2) intercultural dialogue, 3) European citizenship 4) Active participation. All afternoon sessions are dedicated to sport activities that will foster cohesion among groups and promote healthy life styles. This project is initial step-by-step transformation of youth.

So we think that it is important to empower young people and those who work with them (youth leader, artists...) to express themselves freely and independently using the techniques that will impact the wider community and media. We think that young people have lot to say, and that performance, as contemporary form of expressing, gives a possibility for more freely way of communication with surrounding. This training will offer youth workers and young artist who work with youth the skills on how to use the performances as the tool for work with young people and the way on how youth organizations can address important social subjects through Active citizenship. The participants would be trained to use the performances in big events, in the street, in a subway and in any place where bug number of young people are present. That way, performances become an important tool for advocacy and awareness raising.
